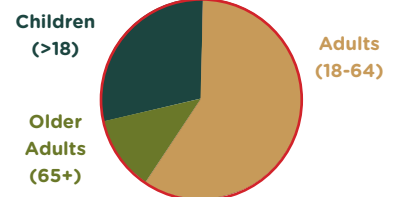

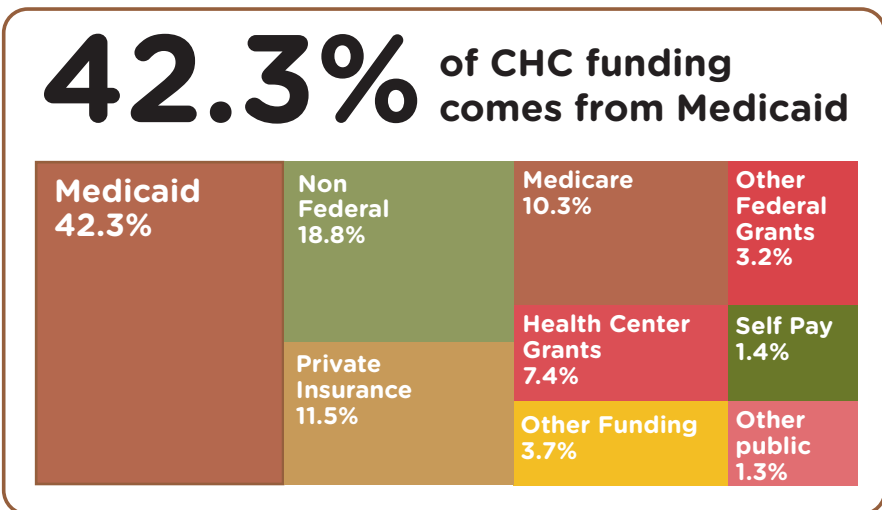
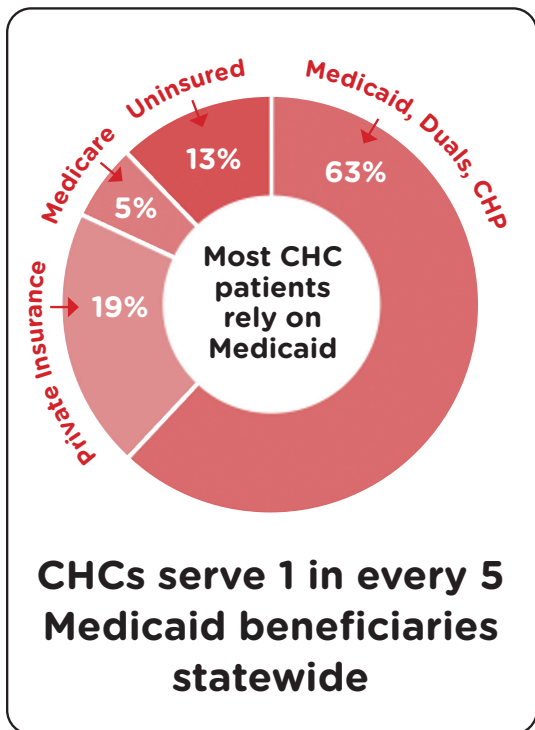
In 2024, Community Health Centers in NYC contributed **\$4.5 billion** to the City's economy and supported approximately 23,100 local jobs.

CHCs dedicated \$445 million in 2024 to providing essential care for uninsured and underinsured New Yorkers.

CHCs serve 1 in 3 Uninsured New Yorkers

The majority of patients live in poverty:

76%

live at or below the Federal Poverty Level

That's \$15,650 for a single adult and \$32,150 for a family of four

And nearly 6% are unhoused
